### Sub: Refund of Balance of Advance payment made to Hospitals for cashless Treatment by RECHS Beneficiaries on final settlement of Bills regarding.

1. As per clause 12.2.4 of the Modified RECHS Scheme covering Hospitalisation in Company approved hospital, an advance of 20% of the charges as estimated by the hospital and the Company may extend credit facility only upto 80% of the charges w.r.t. entitled ward type, wherever credit facility arrangement exists. The beneficiary is also required to directly pay to the hospital concerned any inadmissible charges levied during hospitalization in line with clause 21.1 of the scheme. (scheme available on [http://ecare.bhel.in/jsp/rechs\\_index.jsp](http://ecare.bhel.in/jsp/rechs_index.jsp)).
2. The amount paid in advance by the beneficiary is refunded on settlement of bill received from panel hospital and balance of 20% is paid beneficiary after deducting any inadmissible amount.
3. It has been reported that some of the Units are seeking a separate application/ claim form from RECHS beneficiaries to get the balance of advance amount deposited by them at empaneled hospitals.
4. It is clarified that RECHS scheme does not envisage for seeking any application/ request letter/ claim form from beneficiary for refund of balance of amount so deposited at empaneled Hospital. The balance of amount out of 20% advance payment must be refunded to beneficiary's bank account directly on settlement of bill. The requisite provision is already available in UHMS Billing module.
