Subject: Admissibility of Covid-19 Vaccination to Employees, their dependents & In-house OPD RECHS Beneficiaries – Guidelines for COVID19 Vaccination of children between 15 to 18 years and Precaution Dose

With effect from 03.01.2022, India's National COVID Vaccination Program has allowed COVID-19 Vaccination of children in the age-group of 15-18 years with "Covaxin" as the only vaccination option.

Further, Health Care Workers (HCWs) & Front-Line Workers (FLWs) who have received two doses, would be provided with another dose of COVID-19 vaccine from 10th January 2022 as a matter of abundant precaution. Additionally, all persons aged 60 years and above with comorbidities who have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine, will be provided with *Precaution Dose* from 10th January 2022 based on Doctor's advice. The prioritization and sequencing of this *Precaution Dose* would be based on the completion of 9 months i.e. 39 weeks from the date of administration of second dose.

Accordingly, reimbursement of COVID-19 vaccination may be made to the eligible beneficiaries based on existing rates. The process of reimbursement of COVID-19 vaccine including precaution dose will be same as was done earlier.
